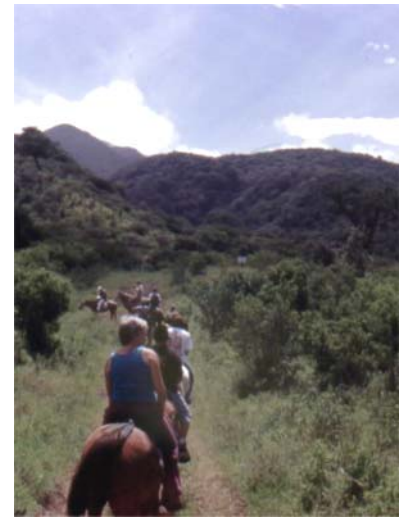


A COSTA RICAN ADVENTURE

THIS EXPERIENCE IS OPEN TO PEOPLE OF ALL AGES. YOUNG PEOPLE UNDER 13 MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT; TEENAGERS MAY SIGN UP ON THEIR OWN; FAMILIES, SENIORS—EVERYONE IS WELCOME. THE PROGRAM IS RUN BY THE INSTITUTE FOR CENTRAL AMERICA STUDIES, AN EDUCATIONAL ORGANIZATION WITH MORE THAN 25 YEARS' EXPERIENCE MANAGING PROGRAMS. WE HAVE OUR OWN EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING SITE LOCATED BETWEEN THE NATIONAL PARKS, AND THE AVAILABLE LODGING RANGES FROM TENT CAMPING TO A LUXURIOUS 5-STAR SPA RESORT.

THE COST PER INDIVIDUAL FOR THE PROGRAM BEGINS AT \$399 AND INCREASES DEPENDING ON CHOICE OF LODGING. GROUPS OF ANY NUMBER MAY SIGN UP, AND IN THE SAN FRANCISCO BAY AREA A REPRESENTATIVE MAY BE ABLE TO MEET WITH YOU. FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:
